NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. When Association Will Conduct Reserve Study. The Association has not conducted, and will not conduct, a reserve study because there are no general common elements, limited common elements or other physical assets located in the Association that are required to repaired or replaced by the Association.
- 2. <u>Composition of Reserve Study</u>. Since a reserve study is unnecessary and will not be conducted by the Association, the question of whether the reserve study is based upon a physical and financial analysis is not relevant.
- 3. <u>Funding of the Reserve Study</u>. Since a reserve study will not be conducted, the question of whether the Association has created a funding plan for reserves is not relevant.
