February 5, 2014 – February 20, 2014	<b>Publish Call for Nominations</b>  <i>(Not less than 75 days nor more than 90 days before election)</i>
February 28, 2014	<b>Self Nomination and Acceptance Forms Due</b>  <i>(No later than 67 days prior to the election)</i>
March 3, 2014	<b>Write-in Candidates</b>  <i>(Any person wishing to be a write-in candidate must file an Affidavit of Intent to be a Write-In Candidate with the DEO)</i>
March 4, 2014	<b>Cancellation of Election</b>  <i>(If the only matter before the Electors is the Election of Directors, and there are not more candidates than offices to be filled)</i>
<b>If Election is not cancelled, the following tasks will occur:</b>	
March 4, 2014 – March 7, 2014	<b>Lot Drawing</b>  <i>(Notify Candidates of the date, time and location of Lot Drawing)</i>
March 7, 2014	<b>Ballot Certification</b>  <i>(No later than 60 days prior to the election)</i>
March 12, 2014	<b>Mail Ballot Plan Submitted by DEO to Secretary of State</b>  <i>(No later than 55 days prior to the election)</i>

<b>DATE</b>	<b>EVENT</b>
March 21, 2014	<b>Election Judges</b> <i>(No later than 45 days prior to the election, the DEO will appoint election judges for the election)</i>
March 21, 2014	<b>Pro/Con TABOR Comments</b> <i>(Deadline for filing pro/con comments pertaining to TABOR ballot issue(s) to be submitted to the electors)</i>
April 4, 2014	<b>TABOR Notices Mailed</b> <i>(No later than 30 days prior to the election)</i>
April 14, 2014 – April 18, 2014	<b>Ballots Mailed</b> <i>(No earlier than 22 days prior to the election, and no later than 18 days prior to the election)</i>
April 21, 2014	<b>Canvassers Appointed</b> <i>(At least 15 days prior to the election)</i>
April 29, 2014	<b>Last Day to Request an absentee or replacement ballot by mail</b>
May 2, 2014	<b>Last Day to Request an absentee or replacement ballot if the mail-in ballot is not to be mailed by the requestor</b>
May 6, 2014	<b>ELECTION DAY</b> <i>(The DEO is required to keep the polls consistently open from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.)</i>
May 23, 2014	<b>The Board of Canvassers is required to certify the final abstract of votes cast to the DEO no later than 17 days after the election</b>
